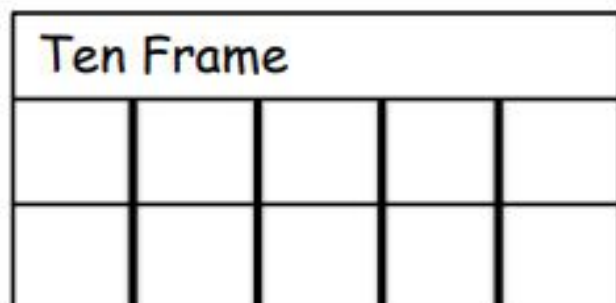

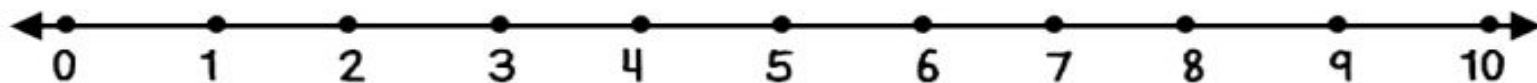


Problem Solving
