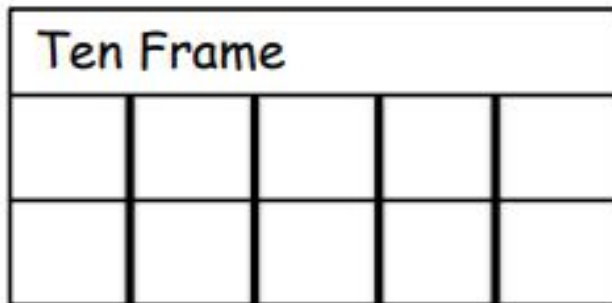

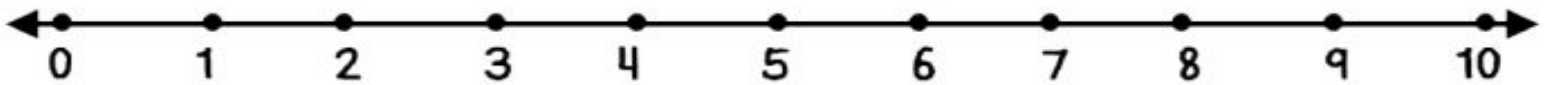


Problem Solving
